This includes:


- making commitments,





Paris Agreement

2015



- COP21
- 196 signatory Parties
- Global commitment to hold temperature increase to well below 2°C, pursuing efforts to limit the temperature increase to 1.5°C

TCFD Recommendations

2017



- Voluntary, consistent climate-related disclosure recommendations
- Categories include Governance, Strategy, Risk Management, Metrics and Targets

SBTi Corporate Net Zero Standard

2021



- Framework for corporate net-zero target setting in line with climate science
- Standardised and robust, with sector-specific guidance

ISSB Standards

2023




- ISSB is an independent, private-sector body
- Develops and approves IFRS Sustainability Disclosure Standards
- Global baseline of sustainability disclosures




Objectives


